International Postgraduate University Study on Diplomacy • MFEA & University of Zagreb, Croatia

The International Postgraduate University Study on Diplomacy has been launched by the Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs (MFEA) of the Republic of Croatia in cooperation with the University of Zagreb.

The aim of this new postgraduate program is to systemize and offer diplomatic know-how based upon Croatia's state building experience, and its specific knowledge of a triple simultaneous transition, i.e. from communism to democracy, from a self-management economic system to a market-oriented economy, and from war to peace and post-war reconstruction and development.

Moreover, special expertise has also been developed in the fields of negotiating with and functioning within the NATO and the European Union, as well as within other international organizations.

The study will bring together junior diplomats and other public officers from Croatia and its immediate and broader neighbourhood, and as such, it will promote networking and mutual cooperation.

Appropriate support and funding schemes will be available particularly for postgraduate students from South-eastern Europe, Southern Mediterranean and the Middle East.

The program consists of three semesters, with compulsory and optional courses held in English by professors and lecturers of the University of Zagreb, experienced Croatian diplomats and foreign guest lecturers.

The study program will be implemented by the University of Zagreb and its Faculty of Economics and Business, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Faculty of Law and Faculty of Political Science, as well as by the MFEA and its Diplomatic Academy.

The curriculum is accredited by international and Croatian experts in the field, and the Ministry of Education, Science and Sports of the Republic of Croatia. The first generation of 2014/2015 begins in September 2014.
