

UNIVERSITY INTERDISCIPLINARY SPECIALIST STUDY IN DIPLOMACY

Call for applications for admission to the interdisciplinary postgraduate specialist program in *Diplomacy* was published on July 10, 2014.

Application form

Study program description

Postgraduate specialist program in *Diplomacy* was established in cooperation with the Croatian Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs in order to unite academic knowledge and practical diplomatic experience. Studies are conducted in English and are intended for employees of the Croatian Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs, foreign diplomats and other interested candidates from the country and abroad. University Senate decided to accredit this study program at its meeting held on March 11, 2014.

Coordinator of the study program

Coordinator of the interdisciplinary postgraduate specialist program in *Diplomacy* is the University of Zagreb in cooperation with the Croatian Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs. The courses will be held by professors of the University of Zagreb (from the Faculty of Economics and Business, the Faculty of Political Science, the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, and the Faculty of Law) as well as by experts from other scientific institutions and the diplomatic service.

Duration of the study

The envisaged duration of the study is three (3) semesters with a total of 90 ECTS points.

Enrolment requirements

The right to enrol this study program have students who graduated a university graduate study program in humanities and social sciences, with a minimum of 300 ECTS points earned, or comparable study abroad. Those who graduated in other fields of study should, in addition to the admission test, have the approval of the head of studies and the Academic Council of the study to attend the program. English language is a requirement.

Academic title acquired upon the completion of the study

University specialist in diplomacy.

The program includes mandatory courses, optional courses and the final specialist thesis.

Structure and rhythm of the study and duties of the attendants

Mandatory and/or optional courses will be taught by semesters. Optional courses will take place if at least ten (10) students sign up. In the first semester there will be five (5) mandatory and four (4) optional courses, in the second semester there will be five (5) mandatory and three (3) optional courses, with 30 ECTS points per semester. In the third semester the attendants will prepare a specialist thesis (a written thesis and its defence before a Commission), with a total of 30 ECTS points.

Enrolled and completed courses from the previous semester are prerequisites for enrolling the next semester.

The study ends with the preparation and defence of a specialist thesis.

Venue

The courses of this study program will take place at the Croatian Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs in Zagreb, premises of the University of Zagreb (Faculty of Economics and Business, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Faculty of Political Science, Faculty of Law) who cooperate in the program, and the Centre for Postgraduate Studies of the University of Zagreb.
